Winemaker's Comments

The 2019 Correlation Wine Company Cabernet Sauvignon is a powerhouse from a spectacular vintage, yet, following on-trend with past vintages, the wine is very approachable and enjoyable right from the start. However, don't let that fool you as this is a serious wine with plenty of aging potential for those looking to follow the evolution in your cellar. The blend of the 2019 turned out to be more heavy on Cabernet Sauvignon, coming in at 92%, with the remaining varietals of Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot making pretty equal proportions of the other 8%.
